**ORDINANCE NO. 1113**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 825 OF THE CITY OF MAIZE, SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, PERTAINING TO IMPOSING A TRANSIENT GUEST TAX UPON SLEEPING ACCOMMODATIONS WITHIN THE CITY; AMENDING THE RATE OF SUCH TAX FROM SIX PERCENT (6%) TO EIGHT PERCENT (8%); CREATING A TOURISM AND CONVENTION PROMOTION FUND TO ACCOUNT FOR THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH TAX AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 825.**

**RECITALS**

K.S.A. 12-1696 *et seq.* authorizes the City of Maize, Sedgwick County, Kansas (the “City”) to levy and collect a transient guest tax upon sleeping accommodations within the City and specifying the use which may be made of the proceeds of such tax collection.

The Governing Body of the City has, by Charter Ordinance No. 33-23 adopted June 6, 2023, authorized the imposition of a transient guest tax of not more than twelve percent (12%).

The City, pursuant to Ordinance No. 825, currently imposes a transient guest tax of six percent (6%).

The Governing Body desires to amend the transient guest tax imposed upon sleeping accommodations from six percent (6%) to eight percent (8%).

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MAIZE, KANSAS:**

Ordinance No. 825 is amended as follows.

**SECTION 1. Transient Guest Tax.**

a. A transient guest tax of eight percent (8%) shall be levied upon the gross rental receipts derived from or paid directly or through an accommodations broker by transient guests for sleeping accommodation, exclusive of charges for incidental services or facilities, in any hotel, motel, or tourist court located within the City.

b. For the purposes of this ordinance, the terms “hotel, motel or tourist court,” “transient guest,” and “business” shall have the meanings set out in K.S.A. 12-1696, as amended from time to time.

c. The tax levied pursuant to this ordinance shall be paid by the consumer or user to the business and it shall be the duty of each and every business to collect from the consumer or user the full amount of such tax, or an amount equal as nearly as possible or practicable to the average equivalent thereof. Each business collecting any of the tax levied hereunder shall be responsible for paying over the same to the State Department of Revenue in the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-1698 and amendments thereto.

d. There is hereby created within the records of the City’s finance department a “Tourism and Convention Promotion Fund” (the “Fund”), to which shall be credited all monies received by the City

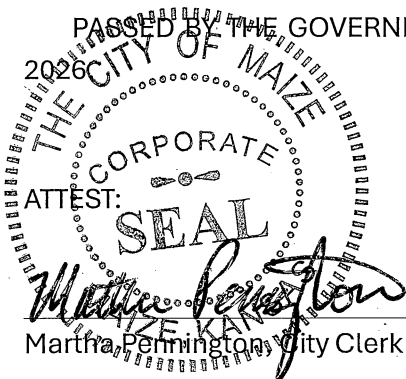
as disbursements from the County or City Transient Guest Tax Fund administered by the Kansas Department of Revenue. Monies credited to the Fund shall be expended only for the promotion of conventions and tourism.

e. The current transient guest tax levy of six percent (6%) shall continue to be collected until the first day of the next calendar quarter following the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the receipt by the Department of Revenue of this ordinance authorizing the levy of eight percent (8%) transient guest tax.

**SECTION 2. Repeal.** Ordinance No. 825 is repealed.

**SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication in the official city newspaper which was designated to be the City's official newspaper by Charter Ordinance 34-25.
