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RESOLUTION NO. 901-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAIZE, KANSAS, AUTHORIZING THE IMPROVEMENT OR REIMPROVEMENT OF CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE COSTS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 15-731, as amended by Charter Ordinance No. 31-20 of the City of Maize, Kansas (the "City") (enacted pursuant to the provisions of Section 5(c) of Article 12 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas) and K.S.A. 12-101 *et seq.* (collectively the "Act"), provides that the City shall have the authority to surface, resurface, pave, repave, curb, recurb, gutter, regutter, or otherwise improve any street or streets, avenue or avenues, or public highway or highways, together with necessary bringing to grade and grading, and with such culverts, drainage facilities and other incidentals as may be necessary, and to build bridges and approaches thereto, any or all of these; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act the City may issue its general obligation bonds to pay the costs of such improvements when authorized to do so by the adoption of a resolution by the governing body of the City describing the street or streets, avenue or avenues, or public highway or highways or parts thereof to be improved, or the location of the bridge to be constructed, and describing in general terms the improvement or improvements to be made and the amount such general obligation bonds to be issued; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City hereby finds and determines that it is necessary and advisable to construct street improvements on 119th Street in the City, such street improvements to include the following:

Drainage, street, and sidewalk improvements on 119th St. W. from 29th St. N. to Wilkinson.

(the "Project"), and to provide for the payment of the costs thereof, all as provided by and under the authority of the Act.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MAIZE, KANSAS:

Section 1. Project Authorization. It is hereby deemed and declared to be necessary to construct the Project under the authority of the Act, in accordance with plans and specifications therefor prepared or approved by the City Engineer.

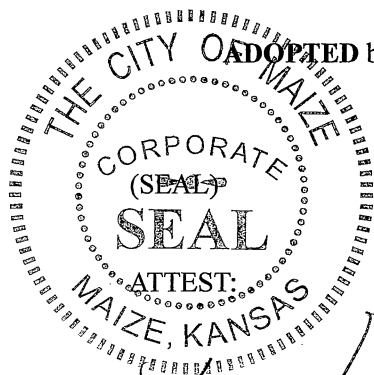
Section 2. Project Financing. The estimated costs of the Project, including construction, engineering fees, contingencies and administrative expenses, are \$1,200,000. The costs of the Project, interest on interim financing and associated financing costs shall be payable from the proceeds of general obligation bonds of the City issued under authority of the Act (the "Bonds").

Section 3. Reimbursement. The Bonds may be issued to reimburse expenditures made on or after the date which is 60 days before the date of this Resolution, pursuant to Treasury Regulation §1.150-2.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by the governing body of the City.
